Reference Staff at the State Library of Ohio are available to help any state employee locate resources they need to conduct research via refhelp@library.ohio.gov.

- **Get the library books, government publications, and DVDs you need:** Find and request library items using the State Library of Ohio catalog [also searches the OhioLINK catalog].
- **Find relevant articles:** Professional journals, individual articles, newspapers and magazines are available online.
- **Access to eBooks:** You can access a growing collection of eBooks covering a wide variety of subjects, including encyclopedias, dictionaries, and other reference works, scholarly books, the American and English Literature collection, as well as computer and technology titles.
- **Ohio historical information:** OhioLINK's Digital Resource Commons allows you to search through 85,000 unique, scholarly and historical records from Ohio's colleges, universities and cultural institutions.
