	Remote access for all authorized users except walkins

Rights:

	Display, copy, print, download, use in scholarly work.
	Copyright/fair use?
	ILL – print or secure electronic, directly from electronic content, no restrictions beyond commercial use.
	Course reserves – print or electronic, directly from electronic content
	Course packs – print or electronic, directly from electronic content
	Course management software
	Scholarly sharing
	Post-cancellation/archiving rights
	Local load and publisher-hosted
	Metadata

Legal stuff:

	Jurisdiction Ohio or silent
	Author rights
	Financial hardship out-clause, controlling board release
	Term? Auto-renew or “manual”?
	Cannot take responsibility for users. No end-user license, clickthrough, etc.
	Breach terms
	Repair for diminished content/value
	No indemnification
	No confidentiality for agreement
	No arbitration
	Licensing goods terms (State of Ohio)
