Overview of College Credit Plus

Ohio's new College Credit Plus can help you earn college and high school credits at the same time by taking college courses from community colleges or universities. The purpose of this program is to promote rigorous academic pursuits and to provide a wide variety of options to college-ready students. College Credit Plus is free to those taking a college course from a public college or university, that includes tuition, books and fees. If you choose to attend a private college or university, you may have limited costs.

Your high school may have an agreement with a local college for specific courses, however, you can choose to take College Credit Plus courses from any college offering courses benefiting your future, including online courses.

College Credit Plus Library Resources

Being enrolled in College Credit Plus means students are doing college-level research. The library of the enrolled institution provides the student with access to the research materials necessary to complete the College Credit Plus course.

eStudentServices eTutoring

eTutoring is a growing collaborative effort between Ohio's two- and fourvear institutions, allowing undergraduate students to interact with trained tutors in numerous academic areas.

Live eChats take place in an Adobe Connect room utilizing audio and video, a whiteboard, document-sharing and instant messaging. Writing students utilize the eTutoring platform by uploading papers for review, and participating higher education institutions provide eTutoring tutors who make suggestions for improvement and development.

eTutoring provides academic support for traditional classes, online courses and distancelearning students. eTutoring is available beyond typical on-campus academic support centers' hours and for students who cannot make it to campus. A clearinghouse of electronic academic resources is available on the eTutoring website.
