

What's the Difference Between a Report and a Research Project?

 Typically, students writing a report simply "stick to the facts" and draw no conclusions from their exploration. A research project requires students to develop their own questions and ideas about a topic. Students must expand the variety of resources they consult, evaluate those sources for usefulness and bias, and apply them to their research question.
